One man is in the Canyon County Jail after a homicide early this morning in the 12000 block of Trinidad Street.

Officers arrived at the home after receiving a 911 call at 5:30 a.m. reporting a shooting. Upon arrival, one victim was discovered, and the suspect had left the scene. The victim was transported to the hospital, but sadly the 21-year-old man passed away. The shooting was a result of a domestic disturbance and is an isolated incident.

The suspect has been identified as 33-year-old Felix Santiago-Torres. After the incident, the suspect drove to the Nampa Police Department where he was detained without incident by NPD and later transported to CPD.

Santiago-Torres is charged with first-degree murder.

"I am saddened about this senseless act of violence that resulted in a young man being murdered. My condolences are with the family during this difficult time, and I am sure that justice will be served," said Rex Ingram, Caldwell Chief of Police.
