The City of Caldwell and Parks and Recreation would like to invite the community to the ribbon cutting for our new outdoor pickleball courts in Luby Park (1200 N. Kimball Avenue). The event will take place on September 12 at 10 a.m.

The installation of these courts demonstrates that there is a growing passion for this sport in Caldwell and beyond. The courts began construction in September of 2022. There are eight courts at Luby Park.

The first tournament on the courts will take place on September 16. The proceeds from this tournament will go toward court lighting.

Pickleball was invented in the 1960's as a leisurely competitive pastime, the game is a combination of badminton, tennis, and Ping-Pong that has increased in popularity in recent years among participants both young and old.
