Caldwell Detectives are investigating a possible child enticement that took place on October 15 at 7:42 p.m. at N. Indiana and Roosevelt. A child in the area noticed a car traveling slowly behind her on Terrace Drive. When the child turned onto N. Indiana Avenue and stopped so did the car. The child thought the driver of the car was waiting for her to cross the road, so she did and began to go south on Indiana, turning east onto Roosevelt. The car pulled alongside her at that time, then pulled in front of her as if to cut her off. The driver then honked the horn at the child and started to turn the car around. At that point, she began to run and made it safely to the home of a friend nearby. The car was red with tinted windows, the model is not known. The man is described as Hispanic and 30-40 years old.

The Caldwell Police Department is continuing to investigate this incident. If you have any information, please call 208-343-COPS or non-emergency dispatch at 208-454-7531. Never approach any suspect/suspect vehicle. We applaud the actions of this child, whose actions allowed her to make it to safety.

Parents/guardians, please remind children of the following safety tips: 1. Never get in the car with a stranger. 2. Tell an adult if approached by a stranger. 3. If possible, walk in groups and not alone.
