CALDWELL FIRE DEPARTMENT PRESS RELEASE

DATE: December 9, 2022

All of the occupants are safe after a house fire in Caldwell overnight. Caldwell Fire Department responded to the home, located in the 100 block of S. 14th Avenue, at 2:18 a.m. When firefighters arrived, heavy fire and thick smoke blanketed the area, and the occupants were outside of the home. None of the occupants or firefighters were injured. Nampa, Middleton and Star Fire Departments all assisted with the fire, a total of seven engines and a truck responded. The fire was controlled quickly, but the home is a total loss.

There were no smoke alarms in the home, instead residents woke up to the smell of smoke. Heating, holiday decorations, and candles all contribute to an increased risk of fire during the winter months, this is an important reminder to have working smoke detectors in your home. The Caldwell Firefighters Local 1821 Burnout Fund and the Red Cross are assisting the family.
