Caldwell is hosting its annual July 4th celebration including a parade, events at Memorial Park, and fireworks! The day will start with a 7 a.m. 1k and 5k Fun Run at Fairview Golf Course (816 Grant St.). You can sign up here: 4th of July Lil' Patriots 1k and Flag Waving 5k Sign Up (google.com)

The parade begins at 9 a.m. at Memorial Park. It will proceed to Kimball Avenue and then head east on Cleveland. The route then turns at S. 18th Avenue to go west on Blaine. It will end at Blaine and S. 5th Avenue.

From 11 a.m.–2 p.m., there will be a celebration at Memorial Park. The park will feature, vendors, a car show, food trucks, and games. You can try to dunk Mayor Wagoner, Caldwell Chief of Police Ingram, Caldwell Fire Chief Frawley, and Caldwell Fire Marshal Alan Perry at the dunk tank in the park! There will also be a watermelon eating contest, a patriotic dog contest, a patriotic bike contest, and a water balloon toss. These events will take place from 1–2 p.m. at the band shell in the park. The finale will be the amazing firework display at Brothers Park. As a reminder, there are several road closures to be aware of as you make your way there. The intersections of Indian, Florida and Middleton on Ustick Road are closed for roundabout construction. The best way to access the park is to come down Indiana Ave from the north (Linden).

There are several parking areas around Caldwell High School, including free handicapped parking just off Indiana near Larch Street. A free shuttle service will take people to and from Brothers Park. The pickup and drop—off area will be in the College of Idaho parking lot at Oak and Indiana. The shuttle will run from 8:30-11:30 p.m.
