## CALDWELL POLICE DEPARTMENT PRESS RELEASE

On May 30 at 10 p.m., Caldwell Police Officers responded to a radio call of a robbery at Jacksons Food Store located on Logan Street. Upon arrival, officers met with store clerks, and the suspect was able to be identified as 21-year-old Jaylene Harrington.

Harrington had entered the store, stated that she was armed with a gun, and demanded cash. In fear, the clerk gave Harrington the cash from the register and she left the scene on foot.

The officers were familiar with Harrington from a prior call earlier in the shift and were able to make contact with her over the phone. After a brief conversation, the officers convinced Harrington to surrender, and she was taken into custody without any issues a few blocks away. No weapon was recovered. Harrington is charged with robbery.

"I am proud of the swift action and keen investigative skills that our patrol officers displayed during this non-routine call for service. Believing that the suspect was armed and dangerous, our officers ran toward the call of duty to protect and serve Caldwell," said Rex Ingram, Caldwell Chief of Police.

All individuals are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
