CALDWELL FIRE DEPARTMENT PRESS RELEASE

A fire broke out on Sunday, July 28 at 3:53 p.m. at an industrial facility on 43rd Avenue and was swiftly controlled with minimal damage, thanks to the building's fire suppression system. The business, which houses significant amounts of combustible materials, greatly benefited from the system's effectiveness, highlighting the vital role of fire sprinklers in protecting lives and property.

The fire, which had the potential to escalate into a major disaster for the community, was contained promptly thanks to the advanced sprinkler system. Battalion Chief of Fire Prevention Lisa Richard remarked, "This incident clearly demonstrates the power of fire protection systems. Their prompt activation not only minimized damage but also prevented a potentially devastating fire from spreading, supporting our commitment to the community. Thankfully, there were no reported injuries from crews or the community during this event."
