Today, Caldwell Police Officers, arrested 57-year-old Patricia Sue Meyer of Texas, on several felony charges. This morning it was reported to CPD that Meyer was at a local bank attempting to complete a wire transfer using fraudulent identification.

When officers arrived, they made contact with Meyer and discovered that she had fraudulently withdrawn over \$5,000.00 from someone's account and later attempted to obtain debit cards from the same victim's account at a bank branch in Nampa.

Meyer then returned to the same Caldwell bank and attempted to complete a wire transfer for over \$37,000.00.

It is believed that Meyer was working with other individuals and this case is still under investigation.

Meyer was booked into the Canyon County Jail on the following charges: burglary; criminal conspiracy; use of a computer to commit a felony; grand theft; criminal possession of a bank card; misappropriation of personal information and forgery.

CPD would like to thank the bank employees for being vigilant and reporting this suspicious activity.

"White-collar crime, such as this, continues to plague Americans every day. I would like to personally commend the bank employees who reported this so we could do our part and bring this person to justice. Come to Caldwell and find out. Maybe in Texas, not here!" said Chief Ingram, Caldwell Police Department.

All individuals are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
